



Invitation to an Inter School Track Event for Underprivileged Children

Hello,

I hope you are having a great day. We are Joya and Maria from 11th Grade from the American Embassy School, and are residents of Gurgaon. We love sports and are interested in encouraging learning through sports. We noticed that there aren't many competitive events for the children in underprivileged schools, and hence we decided to arrange this track interschool fest so that more people would be able to experience our passion. We want to bring out the competitive spirit in kids, discover their sporting talent, and make them smile.

We plan to start off with **holding a 100m race at Thyagaraj Stadium on April 9th at around 4pm**; though that time may be subject to change. We expect the event to last around 3-4 hours, and include up to 10 schools.

Each school can bring up to **2 girls and 2 boys in the U12, U14, and U16 age groups; a total of 12 children per school**. There will be Heats for the boys and girls separately for each age group. The top 8 girls and boys from each age group will be selected for the finals (through time trials) which will be run after all the heats are completed, ensuring that the children have had time to rest between their Heat and Finals. If you have more than one campus, we're happy to count each campus as a different school.

Water and refreshments – snacks, bananas, and juice will be provided during the event, as well as a packed lunch to take home after the busy day. Compensation will also be provided for any transportation costs.

The top 3 winners of each category will be awarded Gold, Silver, and Bronze medals and certificates respectively, as well as potential prize gift bounties including many fun and tasty goodies. All others will receive a participation certificate as well as an event T-shirt to commemorate the event.

All participants will be given points based on their position in their race: If there are 8 schools, each bringing 2 children for their respective categories, all 16 girls or boys who compete against each other will earn points, with the child in 16th place earning 1 point, 15th earning 2, etc. This means that no matter the outcome, the

children will be able to contribute to their teams and every child is valuable.

The school with maximum points, for each gender, will be given a grand prize of **round trip flight tickets**. The winning team and 2 chaperones will be awarded a trip to another indian city to watch a sports match, courtesy of Spicejet Ltd.

We will be getting corporate funding for the event: we have already organized most of the funding and are in the process of requesting further funding for the remaining costs.

We have worked extremely hard on this project and are eager to be able to spread our passion with the children of your school. If you choose to attend, we will work closely with you to ensure maximum comfort for all the participants; we want this to be an extremely exciting event for everybody involved.
